
Beware of Internet Fraud!

Set In Concrete

Davidson of South Devon has recently received media attention for reaching the incredible milestone of having laid one million metres of slip formed concrete. Pete Davidson remains firmly in the driving seat in more ways than one, he is permanently on the road and the majority of the company organisation is done from the seat of his Range Rover. Pete has 80 men working on a 12 hour rotation, 12 hours on and 12 hours off to keep his machines running. 'Usually on an ordinary day shift we can average 300 Linear meters of wall' Davidson said. 'If we go 24 hours nonstop, we will average 700 linear meters. I want to hit one kilometre of production in a day, but we have not done that....yet'



It has taken Pete over 14 years to achieve the million metre mark, but he is very confident that the next million will not take nearly as long. He is currently working in the UK on the Channel Tunnel Rail Link project beneath London and on a tunnel project in Sweden, and now has also won a £9million project working on the M25 carrying out work to the central reservation.

As well as their slip-form machines, PJ Davidson also operate Hyundai R210LC-9 & R145LCR-9 excavators, and with this new project on the M25 Pete has added yet another Hyundai R210LC-9 to his fleet!
