The Real Living Wage, set independently and updated annually by the Living Wage Foundation, is based on the actual cost of living. It is higher than the government minimum and ensures that employees can meet everyday needs.

What this means in practice:

- Everyone who works for us, whether full-time, part-time, or contracted, earns at least the Real Living Wage (and the London Living Wage where applicable);
- We extend this commitment to regular third-party staff, such as cleaners, catering, or security teams who provide services on our behalf; and,
- We review our pay rates annually in line with the updated Living Wage rates to make sure we continue to meet this standard.
